Summary

K2cloud Orchestrator now provides a simpler, self-service way to access and deploy available K2view Fabric releases in K2cloud.

What's New

Available Fabric releases are now automatically published to the Projects page and made available when configuring Space Profiles.

For each available release, K2cloud Orchestrator provides:

The Fabric version and release status. The release date and description. A direct link to the corresponding release notes. The configured container image location for the customer's site. Release information directly from the Fabric Image selection.

What Changes for Customers

Previously, making a new Fabric release available could require coordination with K2view to update the customer's Cloud Manager configuration.

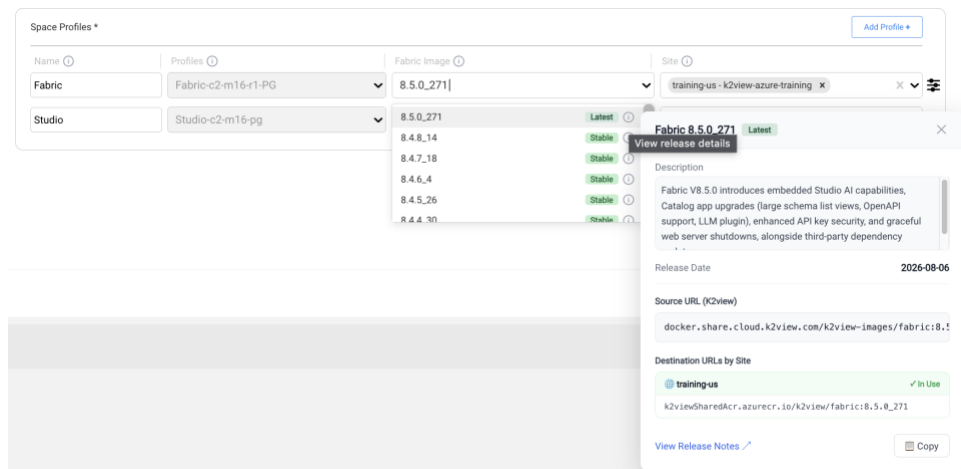
With this release, that additional configuration step is no longer required.

Once a Fabric release is made available by K2view, it automatically appears as an available version in K2cloud Orchestrator. Customers can select the release from their Space Profile and pull the corresponding image into their own container registry using the configured site-specific image location.

This provides a more direct and consistent release process and reduces the need for K2view involvement when adopting newly available Fabric versions.

Release Details

Additional information about an available release can be viewed directly from the Fabric Image selection by clicking the information icon (i) next to the version.





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The release details include the version status, release date, image location, and a link to the release notes.

Important Note for K2cloud Customers

If the Destination URL for your site does not match your configuration, please inform K2view so that it may make the necessary adjustments for you.

You can share this URL internally and K2view by selecting the "Copy" button. This URL is where the K2view Agent will use to initiate the space upgrade to the version selected.
