



FABRIC V8.2.10 RELEASE NOTES

These Release Notes describe the new features in Fabric release V8.2.10 and list bugs that have been fixed since the V8.2.9 release.

MAIN FEATURES AND IMPROVEMENTS

- Ticket #45395 — Web Studio – Query Builder: field values with multiple trailing spaces are now presented correctly, rather than being reduced to a single trailing space.
- Ticket #44787 — the JobReconcile process failed to stop a job, as it also looked for archived jobs; this has been fixed.
- Ticket #45279 — fixing an error that occurred when adding a table to the LU schema if the SELECT statement contained fields with an end-of-line delimiter.
- Ticket #45043 — the crontab editor in the BroadwayJob Actor now validates syntax and guides the user accordingly.
- iidFinder
 - Fixed an issue where child records were not retrieved when a parent primary key changed.
 - Ticket #45183 — enhancing the IfDeltaPresent API to return the following values: true, false, timeout, or error.
 - For Systems of Record, the Delta table must now be updated before publishing to the Kafka topic.
 - Correcting the handling of negative values in the Delta table.
 - Standardizing delete-instance behavior for S3 storage with other storage types. After an instance is deleted, subsequent get and delete operations now fail as expected.
