



FABRIC V8.1.6 RELEASE NOTES

These Release Notes describe the new features in Fabric release V8.1.6 and list bugs that have been fixed since the V8.1.5 release.

MAIN FEATURES AND IMPROVEMENTS

- Ticket #40054 – a new optional input parameter has been added to the DBCommand actor, indicating whether a new interface connection should be established on the active environment.
- Ticket #40246 – adding Service Principal Authentication support in Azure Blob Storage interface.
- Ticket #40460 – the CatalogGeneratorRecord actor now generates fields in the correct date format if classification is not set.
- Ticket #40558 – in a Broadway flow, when there is an exception with numerous details, when clicking the 'Exception Details' button in the 'Run Results' section, the resulting Exception window opens at an excessively large size, occupying the entire screen.
- Ticket #40671 – the Catalog App is caching the value of the 'Use Instance ID' checkbox in the Advanced Settings of the PII & Masking tab . After the checkbox was unchecked and the change was saved, reopening the screen still showed the checked value. The problem has been resolved.
- Ticket #40583 – enhance Web Admin terminal to support older chrome versions.
